PhD in Law (3 years course)

Admission to PhD in Law is extremely selective. Minimum duration of course work is 1 year followed by a supervised research on an approved topic of law of 2 years. In all PhD is a 30 credit hours program carried on under the HEC guidelines.

LLM (1 year & 4 months course)

An LLB graduate i.e. an actual or potential advocate, is eligible to join our LLM Program. The candidate is supposed to work hard and earn 30 credit hours (contained of 24 credit hours of course work + 6 credit hours of research) to claim LLM degree.
