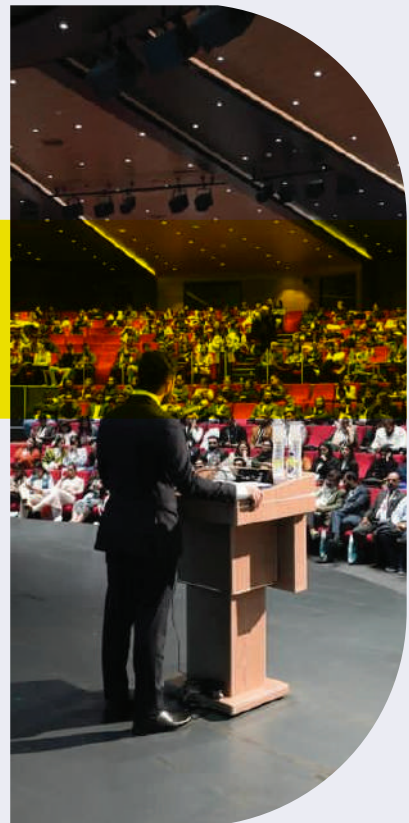

In 2025, it crossed a historic milestone. The 16th ICMR went global, hosted in Tashkent and Bukhara, Uzbekistan. This international leap was made possible through collaboration with New Uzbekistan University (NUU), Tashkent, and Asia International University (AIU), Bukhara. More than 100 participants from across Pakistan travelled together to be part of this defining moment. It was not just a conference. It was a statement. 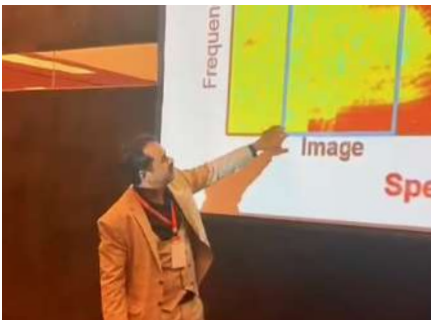

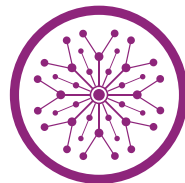
