


Our Governance

We always make dedicated efforts to serve community and contribute towards society by working on UN Sustainable Development Goals for health and the Covid patients were out wellbeing by providing healthcare of reach for middle and lower facilities.

To combat the hazards created by this tough situation the hospital Covid-19, we practiced our value of agility and responded guickly by investing in the infrastructure of Chaudhry Muhammad Akram Teaching & Research Hospital (CMATRH). It has been contributing to our mission of developing sustainable community patients. by providing healthcare services to serve the ailing humanity by providing subsidized and free of cost treatment facilities to underprivileged since last decade. We offer health services through dependable free emergency 24/7 under the supervision of FCPS consultants. Our state of the art hospital facilities include fully equipped ICU, CCU, Operation Theaters, Dialysis Department, Radiology, Pathology, OPD and IPD etc.

The outbreak of Covid-19 not only impacted the public health but also caused a major economic shock. Medical facilities for middle classes of Pakistan. In management was advised to ensure best medical facilities for every patient who walk in the hospital without any discrimination. With this great support, CMATRH provided Covid treatment to hundreds of

We invested PKR 120 million to uplift the healthcare facilities by improving physical infrastructure, beds, diagnostic centers, pharmacy, state of the art equipments and labs.



PKR 120 M + Impact 300+

Overall an investment of PKR 120 million was made to boost healthcare facilities. An amount of PKR 20 million was purely dedicated to establish Covid exclusive facilities including, 20-beds 'Isolation Ward', 27 High Dependency Unit (HDU) beds, 05 private rooms, 10 ventilators, and provision of 'oxygen high flow machines'. Almost 300 plus Covid patients have been treated successfully along with that we have established PCR Lab to improve the rapid response of patient care.



Cath Lab:

CMA Hospital has recently established a state of the art Cath Lab to cater the needs of cardiac treatment procedures like angiography and angioplasty being performed by highly competent cardiologists and surgeons.

PCR Lab: PCR Lab was established to conduct Covid tests which served our community by providing earliest and authentic Covid results. So that Covid treatment measures be taken instantly. Furthermore, in order to ensure healthcare facilities for masses, nationwide chain of state of the art collection centers are being established.

Through collaboration between Chaudhry Muhammad Akram Teaching & Research Hospital and the Government's Sehat Sahulat Program, we have partnered to serve patients having "Sehat Insaaf Card" for ensuring the best treatment and medical facilities to the underprivileged patients in Punjab. Nephrology Suite:

To save lives of kidney patients at CMATRH, we have installed Dialysis Machines. Dialysis Machines are made up of a series of membranes that act as filters and a special liquid called dialysate. The membranes filter waste products from patient's blood to help kidneys function properly



Moduler Operation Theatre:

Operation theatre makes the most important part of any hospital for successful surgical procedures. It was observed in older times that infection rates were very high during and after the surgical procedures. Thus an advanced technology for fully modular theatres was developed to minimize the risk of infection. We have brought this technology of Modular Operation Theatre: with hepa-filters at Chaudhry Muhammad Akram Teaching & Research Hospital to serve our community with its benefits.







CBCT Machine & Ceramic Lab:

Chauhdry Muhammad Akram Dental Hospital facilities have been updgraded by the addition of CBCT machine and Ceramic Lab. The diagnostic and treatment facilities have been enhanced to facilitate patients at our hospital with advanced medical services.

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Mission Essar




Figure 1.1: Mission Essaar Impact




Figure 1.2: Impact of Academic Digitization

Figure 1.2 explains that PKR 42 million were invested on the development of digital infrastructure. 762 faculty members were trained in online teaching methodologies to align with academic digitization. 1441 online courses were taught while around 16526 students were evaluated online.

Our commitment towards investing in our people-Human Capital development

Since we had shifted to online teaching during pandemic, it was also needed to enhance the capacity of our faculty and equip them with the tools required for online teaching. So that the digital transformative system run effectively. Therefore, without any delay we introduced extensive 'human capital development' initiatives. We believe in collective growth and continuously develop and empower the team members to ensure their capacity building. During pandemic we offered exclusive training opportunities to help our teachers upgrade their knowledge and teaching pedagogies needed for effective online teaching to ensure Student Success.

We arranged international online training programs for our faculty development. This extensive teacher training initiative was meant to ensure student satisfaction and teaching proficiency. Our faculty mastered the e-teaching techniques from world renowned institutes and trainers. All the course modules with their learning objectives were redesigned with blended learning approach. Along with international training courses and other certifications, our faculty members were selected to complete rigorous online training workshops. Through these workshops Superior faculty members mastered the competencies to cope up with new, pandemic oriented challenges faced by academia in Pakistan. Online teaching & training courses were accomplished from MIT, BABSON, HARVARD, Stanford University, and RIT.

Figure 1.3 states 568 faculty members were internationally certified while a total of 2574 certifications were done by Superior team members to get trained in digital teaching pedagogies. We invested PKR 102.9 million on our human capital development through these courses and certifications.

Abdul Rehman (Certified Design Thinking Trainer, Stanford University). The Superior team members were trained to solve complex problems by applying 'Design Thinking', an effective strategy tool to cope with the requirements of change created by Covid-era. 

Our education plan under 3U1M includes 3-years of study in university and 1-year of market intensive practical exposure in industry. Through this comprehensive quality teaching and industrial training program, our students develop into the ideal 21st century graduates whom we guarantee job placements.

Under 3U1M Program, we focus on students' overall development so their IQ & EQ ameliorate simultaneously. Their life management skills get nurtured through life changing modules. From Freshman Semester to the Foundation year, from Exploration to Innovation and Entrepreneurship at the university, we ensure our students' market readiness and professional excellence.





Figure 2.1 explains the brilliant achievements of our 3U1M program are evident from the numbers. We launched this program in 15-degree programs and 08 departments. The first cycle recruited 1500 students. Around 250 industrial partners were engaged in three streams with the help of more than 129 coaches who continuously worked on the skills improvements of our graduates. As a result, 843 Design Challenge projects were initiated, 27 start-ups and more than 13 Scaleup projects have been kicked off.





Figure 2.5: ETTP Over the Years 2016-2020

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


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Figure 2.8: Our Social & Economic Impact 2020-21











Figure 2.12: ICK in numbers







Office of Research, Innovation and Commercialization (ORIC) at Superior University is mandated to promote quality research, innovative activities and their commercialization. ORIC has made notable developments to achieve research milestones during pandemic Covid-19 through its subsidiary centers i.e. Chaudhry Muhammad Akram Center for Entrepreneurship **Development (CMACED) and Azra Naheed Center for Research and Development (ANCRD).**

Mission

It is pertinent to mention that Superior University always puts a special focus on research and development as we believe that new knowledge stems from a sound research which drives towards future goals. For the substantial development and progress of any country, research with socio-economic impact always plays a vital role.

Research funds by the government mostly cater to the public sector universities and private sector gets absolutely insufficient minimum share that is why research remain unattended. We always invest in research with our own resources. Despite challenging economic situations caused by pandemic, we allocated PKR 03 Million as research incentives.

Superior Impact Fund

Superior Impact Fund (SIF) is an internal research grant of Superior University for funding research projects on competitive merit for high-guality and promising scientific research that demonstrate strategic relevance and financial impact to the local industry and society. This fund aims to stimulate scientific excellence and the advancement of knowledge. The grant is given to faculty associated with the project and administered through the Superior ORIC. Faculty members are encouraged to submit proposals that are collaborative in scope, with teams including junior and senior academic staff, both male and female researchers and appropriate sectoral/ industrial collaborators. Principal Investigator is also encouraged to include students as part of the project team. These awards are alloted by using a merit-based,





independent and transparent evaluation and selection process based upon international standards.

A two leveled grants plan is established:

Category A: Rs. 50,000.00 to Rs. 500,000.00

Category B: Rs. 500.000.00 to Rs.2.500.000.00





Accreditations

Accreditations and international ranking are the indicators of 'quality of education' while capitalizing the opportunities. 


Figure 2.18: Student Progress 2020




Figure 2.20: Our International Footprint




Figure 2.21: Rector Conference in numbers 2020-21



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
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Superior Mentorship Program

A hotline to take calls from emergency incidents to dispatch ambulance to the venue for transferring patients to the CMATRH emergency for required treatment has been established and team formulated.

CMA Medical Complex will offer a 360 degree healthcare through clinic of consultants, specialising in medicine, surgery, paediatric, gynae, cardiology, pain management, dermatology facilitated through lab facility, x-rays, ultrasound and pharmacy 24/7/365.







